



Culture Connect Legacy Fund - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. How much can my nonprofit request?

Culture Connect will consider grants of all sizes, up to and not exceeding \$150,000 or 100% of the applying nonprofit's last fiscal year annual budget (whichever is less). Culture Connect encourages organizations of all sizes to apply for funding.

2. Can you provide any tips for a successful application?

- Be specific about your organization's work and your impact in the community(ies) served
- Include details on how your work aligns to at least one of Culture Connect's four priority areas of funding: language access, access to public benefits and services, economic empowerment and entrepreneurship, and/or affordable and accessible healthcare.
- Highlight how your organization incorporates language access and cultural competency in your work.
- Keep in mind the timeliness of your funding request. Although the application process is happening now, your organization will not receive funding until the final days of December 2024, possibly into January 2025.
- If requesting funding for a project, provide details on project plans and budget, and highlight how you will ensure the project is completed successfully.

Unsure about whether your organization qualifies? Go ahead and submit your application as best you can.

3. What is the deadline for applying?

The deadline for applications for the Culture Connect Legacy Fund grant is October 17 at 5 p.m. EST. Late applications will not be considered.
